Serving all of Auglaize County

Temporary housing for male individuals as they work towards independent and successful living, giving individuals hope for a better future.

- Participants must be male and at least 21 years of age.
- Program time – 6 months to 12 months
- Number of residents at one time – 2 to 6 individuals
- Program exclusions: Persons convicted of violent crimes, arson or sex-related offenses
- A \$200 entry fee on or before the day of their initial entry into the program. This payment will cover the first two weeks in the program.
- House monitor at the residence – 24/7
- A plan for success will be put into place for each resident
Commitments will be required to programs such as AA, NA, Celebrate Recovery, professional counseling, Bible study, church attendance, etc. (our belief is and always will be that true transformation comes through a relationship with Jesus Christ)
- Rules will be established and reinforced, such as drug and alcohol free, curfew, care of property, work, behavior, etc.
- A set, weekly fee will be established for all residents
- Strict rules will be put in place and consequences for not following those rules will be enforced
- Drug and alcohol screening will be done frequently
- Zero tolerance for drugs, alcohol or other mood altering substances
- There will be daily chores required of each resident
- Must be involved in or obtain employment
- Mandatory attendance at life-skill classes – budgeting, banking, job search, job assistance, GED and spiritual direction
- A waiver of certain rights must be signed by each resident -Eviction proceedings – residents may be removed from the home at the directors’ discretion without prior notice and is denied the process of eviction proceedings -Privacy of personal property - staff may search property, room or vehicle at any time at its discretion -Drug/alcohol screens – residents will be required to submit to random drug and alcohol testing. Refusal equals immediate dismissal.
